### **The Silent Observer Program Goes Digital**

The Silent Observer Program is a non-profit organization run through donated funds that allows citizens to take an active role in the safety of their community by allowing them to anonymously report tips regarding crimes and violence.

The 269-343-2100 phone tipline receives many calls per year, but the new website received 11 percent of last year's volume of calls in its first week of operation!

The new website for reporting tips is: [www.kalamazoosilentobserver.com](http://www.kalamazoosilentobserver.com). The site is set up so that the anonymous tipster receives a unique code number during their visit that they can then use at a later site visit to check the status of their tip.

A final benefit of using the site is that volunteers can ask tipsters more questions with two-way internet communications, while protecting their identity.
